Virtual visits: Connecting to care in the comfort of your home.

Virtual visits use secure video conferencing apps to connect you with Employee Assistance Program (EAP) providers online. With virtual visits, clinicians can assess and treat general mental health conditions, such as depression and anxiety. Treatment is provided by therapists who are part of the Optum provider network.

To get started:

- 1. Log on to **liveandworkwell.com**. Register with your HealthSafe or enter your company access code: aim

- 3. Review the "How it works" instructions, then select "Get Started" to find a provider licensed in your state.
